POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAM

The Triple P Parenting Program is an internationally recognized parenting program which promotes positive caring relationships between parents and their children. This program helps parents develop effective strategies for dealing with a variety of behaviours and common developmental issues.

Stepping Stones Primary Care is a program for parents with children who have a disability that incorporates active skills training process to help parents acquire new knowledge and skills. This program is geared for parents with a specific concern about their child's behaviour (ages 0-12).

Parents meet with a trained Triple P Practitioner, share their struggles and work on a parenting plan that is tailored to the family's needs.
